MR. MEADOWS AND ALISSHA FEELER HAVE MET WITH CITY ATTORNEY RIC HARRIS AND DAVE DOUGLAS. ALISSHA HAS BEEN OUT AT PLANT #2 AND HAS BEEN ASSESSING THE PRIORITIES THAT NEED TO BE UPGRADED. THE LIST IS ATTACHED TO THE MINUTES.

THE CITY ARPA APPLICATIONS ARE DUE NEXT WEEK FOR A FIVE MILLION DOLLAR GRANT. THERE IS A MAXIMUM AMOUNT ON THE ARPA GRANT.

ALISSHA GAVE A DETAILED LIST THAT NEEDS TO BE IMPROVED FOR TREATMENT PLANT #2 . THE ESTIMATED COST FOR ALL THE LIST OF IMPROVEMENTS WOULD BE ABOUT \$7,778,502. THE CITY WOULD HAVE TO SUBMIT A MATCH FOR THE GRANT TO HAPPEN.
